



## **The 2016 nac High Speed Imaging Award**



Outstanding contributions made in the field of high speed imaging are recognized by the nac High Speed Imaging Award which is presented biannually during the International Congress on High Speed Imaging and Photonics. The first of these awards will be presented in Osaka, Japan during the 31st Congress on High Speed Imaging and Photonics. Details of the Congress can be found here:

The award carries an honorarium of \$5,000 donated by nac Image Technology.

The nominations will be adjudicated by an International Selection Committee consisting of acknowledged experts in the field of high speed imaging.

The International Selection Committee will give preference to those nominations that describe contributions made by an individual or small group (3 or less). The contribution of the nominee(s) must have resulted in a significant advancement in a technology that is closely coupled to high speed imaging, or instrumentation commonly associated with high speed imaging. However, recognizing that new ideas often involve totally new concepts, the Selection Committee will also consider contributions that attempt to take the field in new directions.

The acknowledged contribution should be innovative and completed within the last five years. The contribution of a small group will only be considered if the entire group has contributed substantially to the nominated work.

### **NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Nominations should include the following information:

1. The name, affiliation, and contact information for the nominee and the nominator.
2. The relationship between the nominee and nominator. Nominators should take care to describe any personal or professional tie that might be considered a conflict of interest. Self-nominations are not encouraged.
3. A detailed description of the contribution made by the nominee(s).
4. A description of the technical accomplishments of the nominee(s) that are pertinent to this award.
5. Additional materials that might help the Selection Committee adjudicate the nomination. These might include: the resume of the nominee; a record of publications that are pertinent to the nomination; copies of key publications/presentations that describe the nominated work; and previous awards received by the nominee(s) for the same (or similar) work.

### **DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS**

All nominations must be RECEIVED by 11:59 p.m. Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) on Wednesday, August 31, 2016. This deadline is firm. Submissions received after this deadline will not be considered.

### **NOMINATION SUBMISSION**
